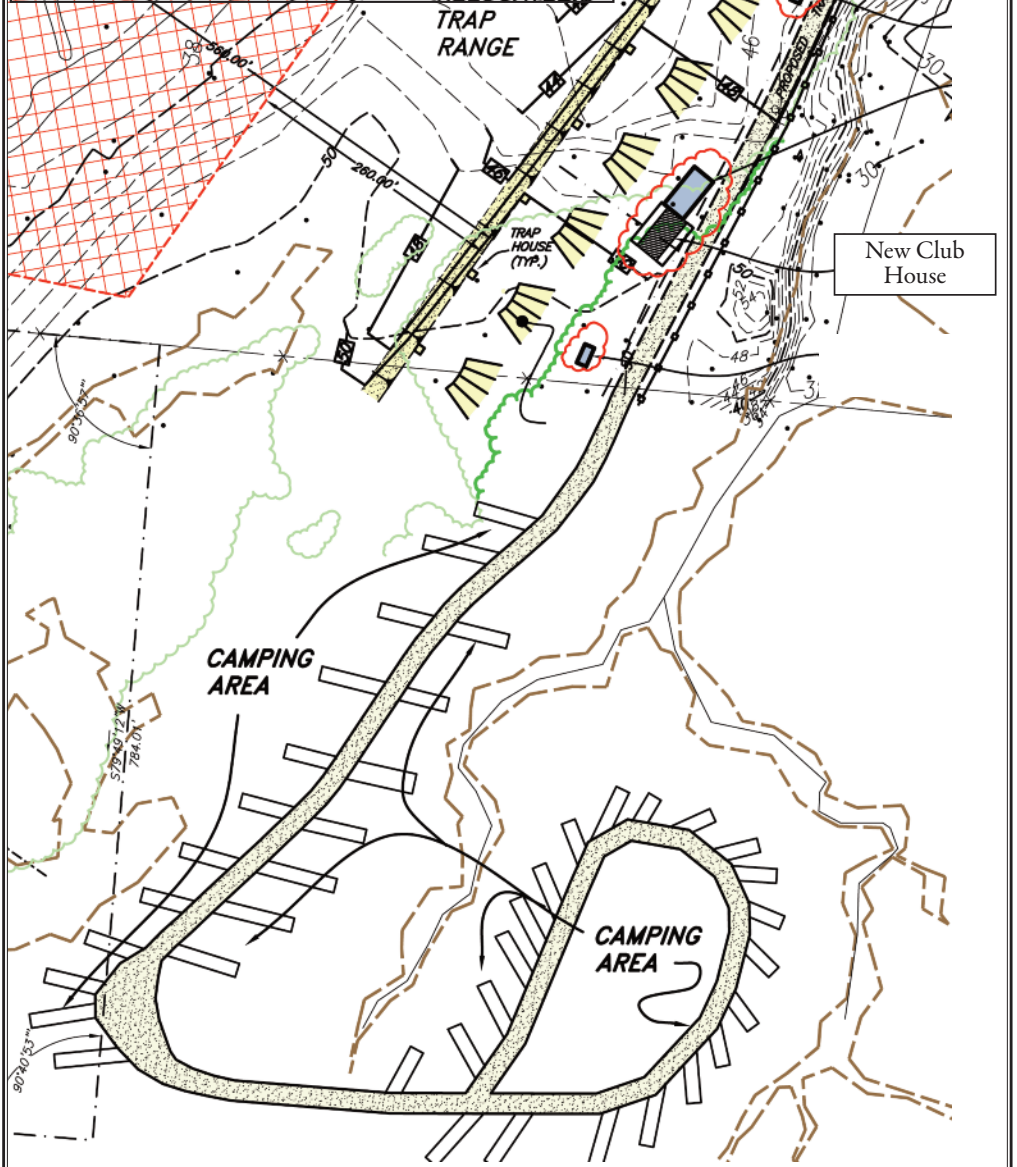

GENERAL INFORMATION

- It is the responsibility of the shooter to be informed of the contents of this program and the rules governing ATA sanctioned shoots.
- All shooters must be classified before making their entries.
- Target fees for all resident sub-juniors and juniors will be reduced by 50 % provided no monies are played. They will be eligible for added monies.
- Management reserves the right to reject any entry and make changes to the program.
- Anyone violating any of the rules may be disqualified and will not share in any prize money or trophies.
- Shooters and spectators assume all responsibilities of any and all accidents at this shoot.
- The MTA president and State ATA delegate will act as a committee to rule on all disputes.

WHITE FLYER TARGETS WILL BE USED FOR ALL EVENTS

- Food service will be available from 7:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.
- Program targets will be shot on 8 fields.
- The practice field will be open at 4:00 P.M. Wednesday, July 14th and daily during the shoot. Practice rounds are \$4.00 per 25.
- R/V parking is available and 50 campsites have been prepared, however, water and power are not yet available. These sites are available on a first come first served basis. - Trophies will be available each day and will not be mailed.
- Cell phones and pagers are not permitted on the line at any time.
- It is the shooter's responsibility to verify his scores on both the score sheets and score board. Once the purses and options are posted, scores will not be changed.
- Starting banks will be drawn at random each day before shooting begins.
- The program for Friday & Saturday will be shot using 10 targets per post.
- Strict adherence to the ATA rules regarding alcohol usage and eye and ear protection will be observed.

- Thursday's Pine State shoot and Preliminary day ties in singles and doubles will be carried over. Ties in handicap will be shot off.
- The ATA rebate to the MTA in 2009 was \$653.00
- It is the responsibility of category shooters to verify that the category is indicated on their classification cards and score sheets.
- Saturday's singles classification will determine the All-Around class.
- There will be a meeting of the MTA Sunday between events. All Maine residents are encouraged to attend.

Classification

Classification will be based on last 600 targets or total average whichever is higher. Average cards must be kept up to date or the shooter may be classified AA.

The Classification Committee will consist of the Maine ATA Delegate/Alternate Delegate, an officer of the MTA or appointee. Classification will be available Wednesday evening from 5:00 until 7:00.

A-----	94.5 and under 96.5%
B-----	91% and under 94%
C-----	88% and under 91%

AA-----	92% and over
A-----	88% and under 92%

Penalty

Shooters not having at least 600 singles or 400 doubles for 2010 and 2009 will be penalized as follows:

Singles	Class B or higher
Doubles	Class B or higher
Handicap	Adult male shooters may be assigned 2 yards over their normal yardage, subject to a 23 yard minimum and a 25 yard maximum Ladies, sub-juniors, juniors and veterans will follow the same rules except the minimum will be 21 yards. No penalty will be assigned to Senior Veterans. Category shooters may elect to shoot for category trophies only and be exempt from penalty yardage.
